Troops have been called out in Indiana to put down rioting coal miners.

The Governor of Ohio called out the troops to put down rioting coal miners last week.

The men who will not work and drive other men away from places that they vacate would in their ignorance destroy free government in less than a week, if they had their way.

Governor PATTERSON last week issued a proclamation against the riotous acts of striking miners in the Fayette county coal district, where the sheriff could not hold the rioters from destroying property and from driving away men who desired to work at the wages offered.

The Governor ordered the rioters to disperse and to refrain from acts of violence and warned them that a continuance of violence will require an enforcement of the law by the constituted authority of the Commonwealth.

W. C. Pomeroy, William Hertzler and W. G. Smith, were appointed a committee on resolutions and reported the following resolutions which were adopted by the convention.
