FARMER'S INSTITUTE, AT MEXICO.

Farmers Institute held in the United Presbyterian church, at Mexico, Pa., February 28, and March 1, 1898. Quite a number of farmers and others attended the first session, the institute was duly organized by electing the following officers, for secretary, M. R. Bashore, President, Edwin Davis; Vice President, S. Blair Hetrick. The institute was opened by prayer by Rev. G. H. Russell, of Mexico, Pa. The address was given by Mr. G. H. Russell, in an able and interesting manner. One of the leading thoughts in his remarks was "How to protect the country church," that this was one of the great problems, the gentleman spoke highly of temperance, of a higher standard in agriculture, and that the men doing the work were in a sense under bondage, even down to the last century, but that now things have changed, and that men avail themselves of the opportunities accessible to all. Responses by Col. J. A. Woodward who said in substance, that in all most men take up their calling in order to develop their physical, moral and intellectual powers, and that practice is always preceded by theory. Dr. Martin in speaking on the Foreign Crop urged the farmers to raise, or grow ensilage corn for feeding stock. He said there were one hundred million cows in this country and that it cost fifty two million dollars a year to keep them. That there can be forty tons of ensilage grown to the acre at a cost of thirty five cents per acre, including all expenses and rent of land etc. E. Davis gave the results of a certain gentleman, who invested three thousand dollars in a farm, on which he kept a certain number of cows, and by careful and judicious management, realized ten per cent on his investment. One of the principal instructions claimed there was an oversight in this ensilage question, and that these feeding the most engring were overlooked.
