



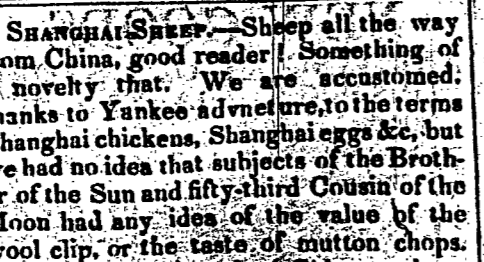
The Thriftless Farmer.
