

Parkhurst writes to the New York Herald that this (Friday) evening May 5th, the moon will rise late enough to allow u to see the comet in the absence of moon light as of twilight, and I have no doubt that from that time until the moon shall again interfere it may be easy seen with a field glass, although it may be at first somewhat difficult to find it; and it is possible that it may be seen by the naked eye before the moon again interferes. 




