True, practice is necessary, as no farmer wi deny, but the experience of the farmer if properly detailed in the telling, is valuable on many points to his brothe farmer on grain raising, stock breeding etc., as would be the actual experience We read a short time ago alletter in a agricultural journal in which the read ers of the paper were told that a syoun man by taking a hint from it acquire a competency. If the farmers who as successful in their different operation would occasionally give details of the plans it would make them none th poorer and would certainly do much aid other farmers. Then do not b afraid to put on paper what you have tried and found out true. Do not hesitate because you do not write very well, or your hand is a little stift. The work of that hand, guided by an active brain, will be the best testimony of the value of your experience, and this will be of practical value to the farmer who has aever yet tried this particular method. Experience is valuable both the person who has had it himself and to the one to whom it is properly told. The work of the practical farmer is of inestimable value to others when it is properly detailed.—Canadian Farm.




