FARM NOTES. Iowa is accredited with producing the largest spring wheat crop of any State in the Union, aggregating 28,607,312 bushels, while Wisconsin stands second in rank with 24,375,445 bushels.

The American Agriculturist says the Jersey red pigs grow rapidly to an enormous size, but the flesh is nearly all fat. Where this is not an objection, this is perhaps the best breed for one who desires to procure heavy pigs at an early age.

Land which without the application of manure will give a yield of fifteen bushels of wheat per acre will, by the addition of eighty pounds of nitrogen, in a favorable season, give from thirty-five to forty bushels of wheat, with a proportional increase of straw.

Hay that has been cut late may be improved by curing it in the cock instead of drying it in the sun. Being comparatively dry when cut it is very soon cured; and if put up in cocks as soon as it is thoroughly wilted, it will heat and steam and become much softened, and will remain greener than in the swath.

The stock kept upon a farm affords the owner a ready contingent market for all the grains and grasses raised, and this market is never overstocked, but the demand is always greater than the supply.

Many fruit growers make the mistake of allowing a tree or vine to carry to maturity all of the fruit which sets after blossom, the consequence, in most cases, being a large yield of inferior quality and size.
