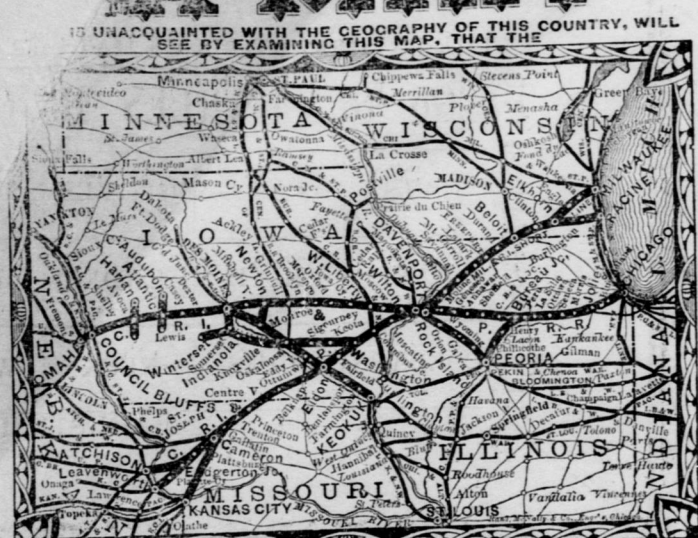


LIFE OF ALEXANDER NICHOLEWITZ, II.
