Results in Increased Profit From Crops and Soil Improvement. A short rotation of crops practiced at the Rhode Island station has been:

GARDENING TOOLS. Weeding implements that apply labor among conveniences that may be made and utilized in gardening operations are some weeding tools illustrated and described in Ohio Farmer.

During the first course of the rotation the value of the crops was less than the total expenses in five out of nine instances. The average loss per acre amounted to \$67.93 per acre during the first course of the three year rotation.

During the second course of the rotation there was an average profit of \$23.54 per acre annually. After deducting the losses during the first course of the rotation from the profits in the second course there remains an average net profit of \$16.75 per acre annually.
