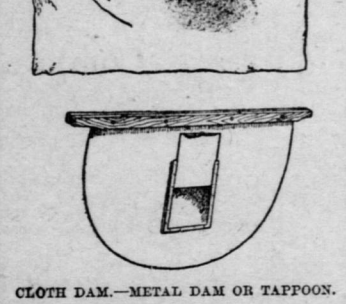




IRRIGATION DEVICES.
