CONSTITUTION OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA. AS AMENDED BY THE CONVENTION OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND THIRTY-EIGHT.

ARTICLE I. The People of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, do hereby establish this Constitution for their Government.

Section I. The legislative power of this Commonwealth shall be vested in a General Assembly, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.

Section II. The representatives shall be chosen annually by the citizens of the city of Philadelphia and of each county respectively on the second Tuesday of the month of October.

Section III. No person shall be a representative who shall not have attained the age of twenty-one years at the time of his election.
