The Regimental Parade!

Yesterday the "fierce revels" of this spirit-stirring drum and fife band resounded through our streets, and all valiant citizens between the ages of eighteen and forty-five, within the bounds of the 37th Regiment, First Brigade, P. M. commanded by the gallant Col. Noxon, were summoned into the service of the country. The Regiment looked as well as usual, and the field officers superb.

Mars was in a splendid sight to see! (For the first time, no doubt, on either hemisphere.) Their vivid scars of mixed embraiders.

Their various arms that glint in the air!

An exciting scene occurred in the organization of the Regiments. When the first Battalion marched into line it was found that a portion of one company, the "Car古代 Greens," had in a flagrant violation of the law made their appearance in certain fantastic and unique dress, not considered uniform under the law regulating the Militia of this Commonwealth. After the consultation among the officers, a file of men was detailed from each company to compose a guard, and the offenders speedily placed under arrest, and load shot from the bystanders and the parties themselves. They were then dismissed by the guard who took possession of certain very formidable sabres, revolutionary "fire-knives" and other warlike weapons, and having thus been relieved from carrying arms, were ordered into the custody of the guard, there to remain until six o'clock, upon very strict parole! After this demonstration that the count was made at 8 o'clock in the morning, in a small but attractive great hall, situated in the principal boarding houses of the delegates, where the delegations formed prior to joining the line of procession at Baltimore street, — that day was cloudy, sultry and threatened rain — and that there was every thing in the glittering scenes on Baltimore street to attract the patronage of the public, is most respectfully solicited, as every care will be taken to give entire satisfaction to all who call.
