BALTIMORE MARKET.

BALTIMORE, Monday, Dec. 4. FLOUR AND MEAL.—The Flour market is very quiet. Small sales of Howard street brands at \$8.12 1/2 bbl. But little doing in City Mills, and the price nominal as last quoted. We quote Rye Flour at \$7, and Corn Meal at \$1.31 @ \$1.30 1/2 bbl. for country and city manufacture.

GRAIN AND SEEDS.—Wheat.—The receipts to-day have been moderate, the market shows no special change and prices firm. About 9,000 bushels offered, and sales of good to prime white at \$1.88 @ \$1.95, choice do., for family flour, at \$1.97—red is very scarce; and we quote good to prime at \$1.85 @ \$1.90 1/2 bush. Lots of inferior qualities sell at 3 to 15 cents 1/2 bushel less. Corn.—The receipts to-day are somewhat larger; the market continues steady. About 27,000 bushels offered, and sales of old and new white at 76 @ 77 cents, old yellow 80 @ 81 cents, new yellow at 72 @ 80 cents, and mixed at 73 @ 74 cents 1/2 bushel. Rye.—About 1,000 bushels offered, and sales of Maryland at \$1.10, Pennsylvania at \$1.22 1/2 bushel.
