ELECTION PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS, in and by an act of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, entitled an Act relating to the elections in this Commonwealth, passed on the 21st day of July, A. D. 1839, it is made the duty of the Sheriff of every county within this Commonwealth, to give public notice of the General Elections, and in such notice to enumerate:

1. The officers to be elected. 2. To designate the place at which the election is to be held. 3. JACOB DOWMAN, High Sheriff of the county of Cumberland, do hereby make known and give this public notice to the electors of the county of Cumberland, that on TUESDAY, the 4th day of November next, an election will be held at the several election districts established by law in said county, at which time they will vote by ballot for the several officers hereinafter named, viz:

TWENTY-SEVEN PERSONS for Electors of the President and Vice President of the United States.

This said election will be held throughout the county as follows: The election in the election district composed of the borough of Carlisle and the townships of North Middleton, South Middleton, Lower Dickinson and Lower Franklin, will be held at the Court House in the borough of Carlisle.

The election in the election district composed of Lower West Pennborough township, will be held at the North School House in said township.

The election in the election district composed of Silver Spring township, will be held at the public house of George Ducey, in Hogestown in said township.

The election in the election district composed of Hempstead township, will be held at the house occupied by Daniel Hickey, in said township.

The election in the election district composed of the township of Upper Allen, will be held at the public house occupied by W. W. Kilne, in Shepherdstown.

The election in the election district composed of the township of Lower Allen, will be held at the wagon-maker shop of Jonas Hutzbarger, on Slate Hill.

The election in the election district composed of East Pennborough township, will be held at the public house occupied by H. Hantzbarger, at the West end of the Harrisburg Bridge.

The election in the election district composed of New Cumberland, will be held at the house formerly kept by Wm. H. Hantzbarger, in New Cumberland.

The election in the election district composed of the Borough of Mechanicsburg, will be held at the public house of John Hoover, in said borough.

The election in the election district composed of 30morton township, will be held at the house of Samuel Alger, in Churchtown, in said township.

The election in the election district composed of Upper Dickinson township, will be held at the house now occupied by John Garman, in said township.

The election in the election district composed of the borough of Newville, in the township of Mifflin, Upper Franklin, Upper West Pennborough, and that part of Newton township not included in the Leasburg election district, will be held at the Brick School House in the borough of Newville.

The election in the election district composed of Hopewell township, will be held at the New Brick School House, in Newburg, in said township.

The election in the election district composed of the borough of Shippenburg, Shippensburg township, and that part of Southampton township not included in the Leasburg election district, will be held at the Council House, in the borough of Shippenburg.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN That every citizen of the County of Cumberland who shall hold any office or appointment of profit or trust under the United States, or of this State, or any city or incorporated district, whether a commissioned officer or otherwise, a superintendent, agent, or clerk, or shall receive any salary, or be engaged in any business, or be a member of the legislature, or of any other public department of this State, or of the United States, or of any city or any incorporated district; and also that any Member of Congress and of the State Legislature, and any member of the Council of this State, or any city, or commissioner of any incorporated district, or any person holding or exercising at the same time the office or appointment of Judge, Inspector or clerk of any elections of this Commonwealth, and that no Inspector, or clerk of any election, shall be eligible to be there voted for.

And the said act of Assembly, entitled an act relating to the elections in this Commonwealth, passed July 21, 1839, further provides as follows, to-wit: That every Inspector shall appoint one or more persons to place appointed for holding the elections of the district to which they respectively belong, before nine o'clock in the morning of the second Tuesday in October, and shall be qualified voters of said district, who shall be a qualified voter of said district.

In case the person who shall have received the second highest number of votes for Inspector shall not attend on the day of the election, then the person who shall have received the second highest number of votes at the next preceding election, shall act as Inspector in his place. And in case the person who shall have received the highest number of votes for Inspector shall not attend on the day of the election, then the person who shall have received the second highest number of votes at the next preceding election, shall act as Inspector in his place.

It shall be the duty of the several assessors of each special, or township election, during the whole time said election is kept open, for the purpose of giving information to the electors of another, that he is entitled in relation to the right of any person assessed by them to vote at such election, or such other matters in relation to the assessments of voters as the said assessors or either of them shall be permitted to give to any person, as aforesaid, other than a white freeman of the age of twenty-one years or more, who shall have resided in the State at least one year, and in the election district in which he is assessed, at the time of the immediately preceding such election, and within two years, past, State or county tax, which shall have been assessed at least ten days before the election. But a citizen of the United States who has previously been a qualified voter in such election district, and who has resided in the State at least one year, and in the election district in which he is assessed, at the time of the immediately preceding such election, and within two years, past, State or county tax, which shall have been assessed at least ten days before the election, shall be entitled to vote although they shall not have paid taxes.

No person shall be permitted to vote whose name is not contained in the list of taxable inhabitants furnished by the Commissioners, unless first he presents a receipt for the payment within two years of a State or county tax assessed agreeably to the Constitution, and give satisfactory evidence, either on his oath or affidavit, that he has paid such tax, or on failure to produce a receipt shall make oath to the payment thereof. Second, if he claims a right to vote by being an elector before the age of twenty-one and twenty-two years, he shall deposit with the assessors of another, that he is a qualified voter in that district, and in the State at least one year next before his application, and make such proof of residence in the district as is required by this act, and that he does verily believe from the account given him, that he is of the age aforesaid, and such other evidence as is required by this act, whereupon the name of the person thus admitted to vote shall be inserted in the alphabetical list by the assessors, and a note made opposite thereto by writing the word tax, if he has paid the same, or the word no tax, if he has not paid the same, and such other evidence as is required by this act,
