TURNIPS .- Common turnips may be sown from the middle of July to the middle of August. We prefer the last week in July, if the weather is not too dry. Almost every farmer has patches of rich low ground where the young corn has been destroyed by the wet weather of the past month, and such ground is generally well suited for turnips, if well plowed and pulverized. Or, what is better still, clear up a piece of new ground where free from grass and weeds, and after plowing or well harrowing, sow the seed at the rate of one pound to the acre and cover with a brush harrow.

VALUE OF PEAT .- Prof. S. W. Johnson, chemist of the Connecticut State Agricultural Society, states in the report of his last year's investigations, that he has analyzed sixteen specimens of peat, some of which contained three to three and a half per cent. of potential ammonia, in their air dry state He estimates that five tons of such peat would be as valua ble as a ton of Peruvian guano, which costa \$60. This kind of guano has six teen per cent of ammonia, and Prof. J. thinks that this substance comprises three fourths of its value.

TO SAVE HARNESS .- It is the hairy side of leather that cracks, and if harnes "is made (if double) so that the fleshy sides are outward, and (if single) so that the hairy side is next the horse, it will not crack. The moisture of the horse will soften the hairy side, and, the bend being so that the fleshy side is on the outside of the segment of the circle to crack. Wagon harness has lasted twenty years undracked simply by this means.

WORMS IN HORSES .- The best remedy I ever tried is this: Feed your horses with plenty of ashes and tobacco once week, and I will guarantee that they will never more bestroubled with worms on botts .--- Tobacco kills them and ashes car ries them away. I handle a good many horses, and this is my remedy. I never had a horse troubled with botts or sick with worms .- Correspondent of Prairie Farmer.
