

A singular fact, and one worthy of be ing recorded; was mentioned to us a few days since by Alexander Duke; of Albermarle. He stated, that whilst at a neigh bor's his attention was called to a peach orchard, every tree in which had been totally destroyed by the ravages of the worm with the exception of three, and these were the most thrifty and flourishing peach trees he ever saw. The only cause of their superiority known to his host was an experiment make in consequence of ob-serving that those parts of worm eaten timber into which nails were driven were generally sound. When his trees were about a year old he had selected three of them, and driven a tenpenny nail through the body, as near the ground as possible Whilst the balance of his orchard had gradually, failed and finally yielded entirely to the ravages of the worms, these three, selected at random, treated precise ly in the same manner, with the excep tion of the nuiling, had "always been vig orous and healthy, furnishing him with the greatest profusion of the most luseious fruit. It is supposed that the salt o iron afforded by the nail is offensive to the worm, whilstait is harmless, or perhaps even beneficial to the tree. A chemical writer upon this subject says: "The oxydation or rusting of the iron by the sap. evolves ammonia, which as the sap rises, will of course impregnate overy part of the foliage: and prove too severe a dose for the delicate palate of in truding insects." This writer recommends driving half a dozen nails into the trunk. Several experiments of this kind have resulted successfully.


