piles, where it may undergo that fermen-tative process which renders the constituents more readily soluble, and therefore of immediate benefit to the future crop? If all these things have been properly cared for, the work for the season has been well commenced, and the general operations of the farm will not have been retarded by causes that might have been avoided. Upon a portion of those operations we now proceed to treat.

WINTER PLOWING. If the season should prove to be an early one, seize the oportunity to break up any stiff clays that you design to bring under cultivation; proivded they are in a lit state for the reception of the plow. It is absolutely necessary that they should be in a proper condition for tillage before they are disturbed, or the cvil effects arising from a contrary state of things will seriously impair their productiveness . No stiff clay soil should be plowed while it is wet and adhesive: for it will then harden almost to the consistence of mortar, and under such circumstances it breaks into clods, becomes almost inert, and is rarely susceptible of being brought under those atmospheric influences upon which the vigor of the growing plant so much depends. But if, upon examination, it is found that the soil pulverizes readily be fore the plow, press the work forward at once, and let the harrow follow immediately. PREPARING FOR OATS.

Although it is entirely too early during this month to seed down to oats in any of the Middle States, it may yet be practical ble to break up the ground in readiness for their reception; for the sooner oats are seeded after all danger of heavy frosts has disappeared, the more certain will be the chances of a full crop if the land is in good condition. The soil should be plow-ed deeply, and if of a clayey texture, shuold be thoroughly harrowed and cross harrow ed until it is completely pulverized; for the finer the seed bed is made the sooner the seed will quicken and germinate. As oats will flourish on almost any good soils, there is frequently less discrimination ex-ercised than there might by with regard to the most appropriate soil for bringing this most useful cereal to perfection It should, however, be always borne in mind py those who h we a choice of fields to select from, that the best soil for the oat is a moist, deep, clay loam, abounding in vegetable matter; the heaviest crops being always taken from fresh soils newly broken up, and from old pastures. Dry. gravelly or light sandy soils are those that are the most unfit for the production of this grain. If oats are cultiveted on stiff grass land, the sward should be turned completely over to fareilitate, by its rapid decomposition, the growth of the plant. If the soil has become impoverished, it will , be found of essential advantage to give it. a top-dressing of either of the following mixtures to be harrowed in with the seed 1st. Eight bushels of bone dust, 10 of a-hes, 1 of plaster, and 2 of salt. Mix together and leave standing a few days before using 2nd. 2 owt. of mixed guano, 5 bushels of ashes-10 would be better-1 bushel of plaster, and 2 of salt. 3d. 10 two-horse cart.


