

SOUTHERN CRITICISM ON THE WAR.

An "Office," writing in the Richmond Examiner, ventures a criticism upon the late reverses at Fort Henry and Roanoke Island, which, "though it may be grating to ears polite," he thinks is rendered necessary by the condition of the Southern army.

It is high time that these surrenders should cease, for, considering the character of the war in its consequences to us, they have been truly amazing, commencing with that of the cavalry at Alexandria, Mountain, that of Commodore Barron at Hatteras, &c. to the present lamentable instance.

The Roanoke affair is perfectly incomprehensible. The newspapers are filled with extravagant laudations of our valor; the annals of Greece and Rome offer no parallel; whole regiments were defeated by companies, and the whole army by a single division. Our men finally surrendered "with no blood on their bayonets" and what is the loss? Richmond, Blaine, two killed and five wounded; McCullough, Hargraves, one killed and two wounded; other four or five killed; but in all two killed and eleven wounded. Let it be remembered that the whole army had better surrender at once, for it will eventually come to it.

THE TREASURY NOTES. The New York Herald, one of the most earnest opponents of the issue of Treasury demand notes, speaks as follows of the expected results of the passage of the bill authorizing their issue by Congress:

The banks throughout the country are making arrangements for large issues of demand notes, based on the \$450,000,000 of demand notes made a legal tender. The legal tender clause makes demand notes the same as gold to redeem bank notes. But they possess one great advantage over gold for banking upon which gold has not. They will never be wanted for shipment abroad. The banks, therefore, will not be compelled to contract their paper issues when the foreign market is closed. The United States Treasury, because the \$450,000,000 demand notes will always remain with the banks, whereas, if they had \$450,000,000 in gold, a foreign drain might take the gold from them, and, in consequence, the superiority of demand notes over gold, as a basis for bank issues, is very apparent, and admits of no question. The legal tender bill, in fact, gives the banks \$450,000,000 of a perfect substitute for gold, which no foreign drain can take from them, and thus insures to the country plenty of money and no bank contractions. If the banks can get out three dollars in bills for one dollar of demand notes, which are by law a legal tender, the country will have three additional bank notes circulating of \$450,000,000, instead of the present limited amount of \$150,000,000. The bank note engraving business is expected to be very prosperous for some time to come.
