

them through these columns two year ago, they, as well as our butchers, would now be better off. We advised, among other things, against the killing of their calves, and warned them that cattle would soon become scarce if they continued the wanton practice. Few of them, however, heeded our advice, and we are now reaping the fruits of their obstinacy and selfishness. Had they realized their calves they would have been well remunerated for their trouble, and the present scarcity of cattle would not have taken place. We hope the Legislature may pass a law making it a crime to kill a calf during the continuance of the war.

But why should everything be up in price? "On account of the war," answers the seller. Fiddlesticks! What has the war to do with hens laying eggs, cows giving milk, or the raising of cabbage? The fact that eggs, milk, cabbage, and a hundred other articles consumed by housekeepers are not used in the army, should rather tend to lower these articles instead of putting them up in price. No, it is not on "account of the war" that we are paying such outrageous prices for marketing. It is because these prices are asked and we town people yield to the demand. That is the whole secret. We have never been in the habit of complaining because of high prices, but really it is almost impossible for a man of ordinary business to maintain his family at the present rates of living. It amounts to an imposition and an outrage.

Another thing is felt in our market, and this is the want of corn. We believe many more farmers would bring their products to market but for this cause. Let our town authorities build another wing to the market-house and remedy this evil. Considering the population of our town, the present market-house is entirely too small. We hope the Council will look at this evil and apply the remedy.—Volunteer.

Met agreeably to adjournment in School House No. 7 (4th St.) Saturday Feb. 27.
MORNING SESSION.—Absent, Mr. Scholtenberger. The minutes of the last meeting were read and adopted. A Selection was read by Mr. Kluge.
Mr. Goodyear, skillfully conducted a class drill in Written Arithmetic.
AFTERNOON SESSION.—Absent, Messrs. Soltenberger, Berkeimer and Boyer. The subject of the written Arithmetic was discussed a some length by Messrs. Eberly, Kohnwin, Schriver, Kluge and Graybill.

Mr. Graybill delivered an excellent Lecture on "The Evils of Ignorance." With forceful language and apt illustration he exhibited the sad results arising from ignorance of reading, writing, spelling, arithmetic, grammar, geography, physiology and phonology. The question "Are pupils examinations and exhibitions advisable" was taken up.

Mr. Goodyear, after examinations furnish an excellent incentive to teachers and pupils to improve their time well.

Mr. Eberly—There should be frequent but not special examinations. School should be visited often. Persons who visit schools only on examination days are not cognizant of the school. There is a danger of discouraging dull pupils at special examination. The discussion of this subject was closed for the day.

Mr. Kohnwin read an interesting and instructive Essay on "The Evils of Ignorance of the mind." Mind power is the measure of the man. A well cultivated mind brings respect and honor into any avocation or calling in life. A cultivated mind only can be truly happy. It has a thousand resources in itself and need not depend on outward feeling or circumstances. To cultivate the mind we must enforce habits of attention; must implant the elementary principles of science, law, government, religion in the mind; must teach the power of using language aright in speaking and thinking; must lift the mind with the materials of thought; with facts; must teach the mind how to investigate subjects and draw therefrom reliable conclusions; must cultivate the memory.
