PRESERVING FRUIT.

As the season for preserving fruit has already commenced, a lady friend has kindly furnished us the following receipts, showing the proper method to follow in boiling various kinds of fruit, together with the amount of sugar required for each kind to the quart, which will be of interest to many housekeepers, and, perhaps, of use to them:

- Cherries, boil five minutes, in six ounces of sugar.
- Raspberries, boil six minutes, in four ounces of sugar.
- Blackberries, boil six minutes, in six ounces of sugar.
- Strawberries, boil eight minutes, in eight ounces of sugar.
- Plums, boil ten minutes, in eight ounces of sugar.
- Whorlberries, boil five minutes, in four ounces of sugar.
- Pineapples, sliced, boil ten minutes, in ten ounces of sugar.
- Small Sour Peas, whole, boil thirty minutes, in eight ounces of sugar.
- Bartlett Peas, in halves, boil twenty minutes, in six ounces of sugar.
- Peaches, boil five minutes, in four ounces of sugar.
- Peaches, whole, boil fifteen minutes, in four ounces of sugar.
- Pineapple, sliced, boil fifteen minutes, in six ounces of sugar.
- Siberian or crab apple, boil twenty-five minutes, in eight ounces of sugar.
- Sour apples, quartered, boil ten minutes, in five ounces of sugar.
- Ripe currants, boil six minutes, in eight ounces of sugar.
- Wild Grapes, boil ten minutes, in eight ounces of sugar.
- Gooseberries, boil eight minutes, in eight ounces of sugar.
- Quinces, sliced, boil fifteen minutes, in ten ounces of sugar.
- Tomatoes, boil twenty minutes, without sugar.
