

The Texas Harvest.
The cotton from Texas, of the 20th inst., says:
"Our farmers have already gathered eight million bushels of cotton; and the spring wheat, which is coming on finely, will be ready for harvest by the middle of June. Regarding the quantity of the yield, about fifteen or twenty bushels to the acre is a fair average crop. The corn that was not damaged by the frost has grown luxuriantly, and is ready for harvesting about the 15th of June. Our average yield per acre is about fifty bushels on the bottom land and thirty bushels on the uplands; seventy-five bushels per acre; throughout an entire season, in favorable seasons, the good bottom lands."
