

LATER FROM CALIFORNIA.

Springfield, Missouri, June 23.—The overland mail with California advices to the last of June has been received.

There is great excitement in Western Utah, caused by Indian hostilities. The Indian attacks have extended from Walker River to Hoop Lake, necessitating the discontinuance of the Pony Express.

The main body of Indians are concentrated at Pyramid Lake, where Col. Ormsby's party were defeated, and where, as is now ascertained, over one hundred Indians were killed.

On the 29th of May, Col. Jack Hayes, with a party of over six hundred volunteers, and Capt. Stewart, with sixteen government troops, started for the Indian camp at Williams station, Carson river, where the first Indian murders occurred.

A fight ensued with three hundred Indians, who were defeated, with seven killed, including a principal chief. Two volunteers were wounded.

On the 31st another party of regulars and volunteers started for Pyramid Lake, with the intention of forcing a general battle with the Indians. Intense anxiety is felt as to the result, for if the troops are defeated the most disastrous Indian war ever known will be inevitable.

The effect of this disturbance has been to concentrate all the mining population of the Washoe region within a very small compass in the vicinity of the settlements.

All the accounts from the new mines indicate their richness and extent.

The Washoe war is about the only topic of interest in California.
