Shall We Plow in the Fall.

All lands, except light loams and sandy soils, are benefited by fall plowing unless they are exposed to washing.

But all heavy loams lying flat, and clays are greatly benefited by fall plowing. The teams are generally in the best condition for plowing at this season.

In the Fall, the lands that are most benefited by plowing are generally in the best condition for the operation.

By plowing now, they are prepared to receive the full benefit of the action of the frost rain and snow through the Winter.

Besides this, plowing has an important influence upon insect life. Many insects burrow in the earth, and it left undisturbed, come forth with new life in the Spring.

Corn Stalks.

The practice of placing corn stalks uncut before cattle still prevails in many parts of the country. The blades are eaten off, the tender part of the top, perhaps, consumed, and the rest left on the ground to decay.

We have long since advocated the cutting and steaming of corn stalks, and their admixture with slight quantities of ground feed, to induce the cattle to consume them.

With such treatment we succeed in having them cleanly eaten up, but when the stalks are cut and not steamed, even when supplied with a slight quantity of moistened feed, great waste occurs.

The analysis of the corn stalk shows its value as food for cattle to be very considerable, and the immense crop now raised of this staple warrants every experiment for the economical use of the stalks to be carefully made.

How to keep Potatoes.—More potatoes are spoiled through sweating than freezing. I never lose any, but save them thus. I raise the place six inches, where I want the pit or hole, beating it hard with the spade.

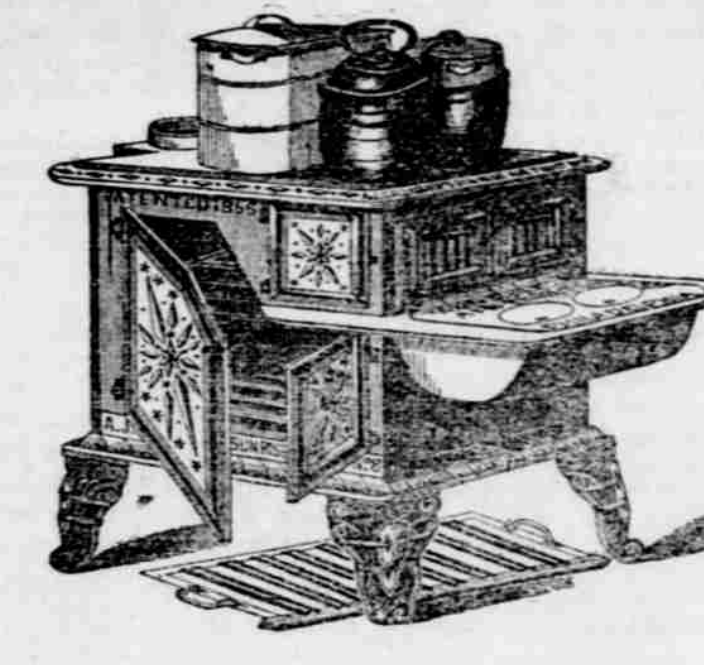
