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The Volunteer Bill. INQUIRY INTO THE WAR DEPARTMENT CONTRACTS. WASHINGTON, July 12.—The volunteer bill, which passed the house to-day, has yet to be acted upon by the Senate.

Mr. VAN WYCK'S amendment was voted down. It proposed that the Chaplain, or other competent person of every regiment, be appointed Post master, to frank letters and papers for all officers, musicians and privates.

It appears, by an order just issued, that the Quartermaster's Department will provide horses, and the Ordnance Department will furnish horse equipments for volunteer cavalry companies, upon the requisition of the mustering officer, as fast as such companies are mustered into the service.
