LETTER FROM CAMP TENNALLY.

CAMP TENNALLY, Sept. 1st, 1861. FRIEND MURRAY.—Since writing my last to the Pennsylvania brigade has been reviewed once, first on Saturday afternoon, Sept. 5th, by Gen. M. Call, and on the Monday following by Gov. Curtin.

The Cincinnati Association of Philadelphia raised the sum of \$3000 and presented it to the state of Pennsylvania, to be used for war purposes. The legislature directed Gov. Curtin to purchase fifteen stand of colors and to personally present them to the Pennsylvania Reserve Volunteer Corps.

The regiments were then drawn up into line. Only 11 of the 12 regiments were present, the 9th being at Great Falls doing picket duty. The Color companies E, of each regiment were placed in line in front of the brigade. Gov. Curtin then passed along this line and addressed to each regiment a full stand of colors.

The brigade then marched in review before the Gov. and a large assemblage of others who had come to witness the grand military display. Among the noted celebrities present as spectators, were Gen. McClellan and staff, President Lincoln and Secretary Cameron.

The colors presented to the regiments are really beautiful. In the centre of the blue field the coat of Arms of the State of Pennsylvania is placed surrounded by the stars designating the States in the Union. Gov. Curtin will immediately proceed to Gov. Bunk's Division, where a presentation of three stands of colors will be made to the Reserve Pennsylvania Regiment in that Division.

Five companies of the 11th were out doing picket on last Wednesday and Thursday. Among them was Co. A. Wednesday night being very wet and stormy, this duty was about the worst we have had to do yet. While we were out on picket the brigade received marching orders, and part of it was marched to the Chain Bridge. This order was caused by a skirmish which occurred on the Virginia side Wednesday afternoon, as I presume you have already noticed in the city papers.

The services of the Pennsylvania regiments not being needed they were marched back to their quarters during a very heavy shower of rain late on Wednesday evening. Three cases of accidental shooting occurred since I last wrote. A soldier in the 10th regiment doing guard duty, accidentally discharged his musket, the ball striking him in the head and killing him almost instantly.

The third and last case that I have any knowledge of occurred in our regiment. One of the guards by carelessness accidentally shot his musket off the ball striking Colonel Gallagher's horse in the neck. The wound is not fatal and the animal will probably recover. The health of the camp is better at present than it has been for some time. Despite the exposure and fatigue incident to a soldier's life we are all in the best of spirits.

Last Wednesday night when out in a rain which perfectly saturated all our clothing, the utmost hilarity prevailed, and the exclamation "who would not be a soldier," was frequently heard.

Election Proclamation.

PURSUANT to an Act of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, entitled "An Act relating to the Elections of this Commonwealth," approved the 2nd day of July, A. D. 1859, I, ROBERT P. LINTON, High Sheriff of the County of Cambria, in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, do hereby make known and give notice to the Electors of the County aforesaid that a GENERAL ELECTION will be held in the County of Cambria on the SECOND TUESDAY, being the 8th day of OCTOBER, A. D. 1861, at which time State and County Officers will be elected, to wit:

One person in conjunction with Blair, Huntingdon and Cambria to fill the office of President Judge of the County of Cambria.

One person to fill the office of member of the House of Representatives of the State of Pennsylvania.

One person to fill the office of Sheriff of said county.

One person to fill the office of Treasurer of said county.

Two persons to fill the office of Associate Judge of said county.

One person to fill the office of Director of the Poor and House of Employment of said county.

One person to fill the office of Auditor for said county.

The electors of the township of Allegheny to meet as follows, to wit:—The electors of the district composed of that part of said township of Allegheny, beginning at the line dividing Blair and Cambria counties, at a point on the dividing line of two tracts of land, one of which is warranted in the name of Aaron Bowen, and the other in the names of Mary Bowen and Jean Lewis, thence south 83 degrees west 23 perches, thence south 29 degrees west to a point on the old Burgoon Gap road, thence along said road to the township road leading to Burnt Mills, thence south 13 degrees west 36 1/2 perches to Dawson's Mills and house, thence along the township road to Burnt Mills, to dividing line between Allegheny and Washington townships, thence along Washington township line to dividing line between Cambria and Blair counties to meet at the School House, in the town of Gallitzin, in said district; and the electors of that part of said township of Allegheny, residing outside of the above described boundaries, to meet at School House No. 9 in said township.

And I further give notice, as in and by the 13th Section of the aforesaid Act I am directed to do, That all persons, excepting Justices of the Peace, who shall hold any office or appointment of profit or trust under the government of the United States, or of this State, or any City or incorporated District, whether a commissioned officer or otherwise, a subordinate or agent, who is or shall be employed under the legislative, judiciary or executive department of this State or the United States, or any City or incorporated District; also, that every member of Congress and the State Legislature, and of the select or common councils of any incorporated district, is by law incapable of holding or exercising, at the same time, the office or appointment of Judge, Inspector, or Clerk of any election of this Commonwealth, and that no Inspector, or Judge, or other officer of any such election shall be eligible to any office then to be voted for.

Also, that in the 6th section of said Act it is enacted that "every general and Special Election shall be opened between the hours of eight and ten o'clock in the forenoon, and shall continue without interruption or adjournment, until seven o'clock in the evening, when the polls shall be closed."

The general, special, city, incorporated district, and township elections, and all elections for electors of President or Vice President of the U. S., shall be held and conducted by the Inspectors and Judges elected as aforesaid, and by clerks appointed as hereinafter provided. No person shall be permitted to vote at any election, as aforesaid, but a white freeman of the age of twenty-one years or more, who shall have resided in this State at least one year, and in the election district where he offers to vote at least ten days immediately preceding such election, and within two years paid a State or County tax which shall have been assessed at least ten days before the election. But a citizen of the U. S., who had previously been a qualified voter of this State, and removed therefrom and returned, and who shall have resided in the election district, and paid taxes as aforesaid, shall be entitled to vote after residing in this State six months. Provided, That the white freemen, citizens of the United States, of the age of twenty-one years and twenty-two years, and have resided in the election district ten days as aforesaid, shall be entitled to vote, although they shall not have paid taxes.

No person shall be permitted to vote whose name is not contained in the list of taxable inhabitants, furnished by the assessor, at least ten days first he produce a receipt for the payment within two years of a State or County tax, assessed agreeably to the Constitution and give satisfactory evidence, either on his oath or affirmation, or that of another, that he has paid such tax, or on failure to produce a receipt, shall make oath of the payment thereof, or, secondly, if he claims the right to vote by being an elector before the age of twenty-one and twenty-two years, he shall depose on oath or affirmation that he has resided in the State at least one year before his application, and make such proof of his residence in the district as is required by this Act and that he does verily believe, from the accounts given him, that he is of the age required by this Act, and that his residence as is required by this act, whereupon the name of the person so admitted to vote, shall be inserted in the Alphabetical list by the Inspectors, and a note made opposite thereto by writing the word "Tax" if he shall be permitted to vote by reason of having paid tax; or the word "Age" if he shall be permitted to vote by reason of his residence as is required by this act, and the name of the person so admitted to vote, shall be inserted in the list of voters kept by them.

In all cases where the name of a person claiming to vote as found on the list furnished by the Commissioners and Assessors, or his right to vote, whether found on the list or not, is in dispute, the Inspectors to examine such person on oath as to his qualifications, and if he claims to have resided within the State for one year or more, his oath shall not be sufficient proof thereof, but shall make proof thereof by at least one competent witness, who shall be a qualified elector, that he has resided in the State for the time specified in the act, next preceding said election, and shall also himself swear that his bona fide residence, in pursuance of his lawful calling, is within the district, and that he did not remove into said district for the purpose of voting therein.

Every person qualified, as aforesaid, and who shall make due proof, as aforesaid, shall be admitted to vote in the township, ward, or district, in which he shall reside.
