

than the misnomer which the act so studiously applies to the militia—some reason that deserves to stand instead of Magna Charta, our Constitution, and all our traditional freedom.

The only general reason that I have ever heard suggested, and which is applicable against all the views advanced in this opinion, is called military necessity. The country is involved in a great civil war which can be brought to an honorable close by an energetic use of all our resources, and no restraints should be tolerated, in such circumstances save only those which christian civilization has imposed on all warfare.

The amount of the argument is that the exigencies of the times justify the substitution of martial law for the Constitution. But what is martial law? Blackstone and Sir Mathew Hale tell us "it is built upon no settled principles, but is entirely arbitrary in its decisions, and is in truth and reality no law, but something indulged rather than allowed as law."
