-A most heart-reading assident occurred in Alsppo in, near Steabeurille, Ohie, on the 25th alt. After making several aneuereseful attempts to effect an entrance, in order to resous her shild from the devouring fames, her isthes anfortanately eaught fire and were literally oon stmed. When Mr. Lyons returned he found Mrs. Lyons lying a short distance from where the house had stood, almost in the agonies of douth. The child was not rescued, and nothing remained of it but a few of its bones.






