The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to the Sheriff of Cameron County, Greeting:
We command you that you attach Cornelius Kidder, late of your County, by all and singular his goods and chattels, lands and tenements, in whose hands or possession the same may be, so that he be and appear before our Court of Common Pleas, to be holden at Emporium, in and for said County, on the 12th day of March next, there to answer James Birkhead and Testament of Hugh Birkhead, deceased, of a plea of debt; and also that you summon the persons in whose hands the property is, that they be and appear before our Court, on the said day, to answer what shall be objected against them, and abide the judgement of the Court therein. And have you then and there this writ.
Witness the Hon. R. G. WHEE, President Judge of our said Court, at Emporium, this 8th day of January, A. D. 1866.

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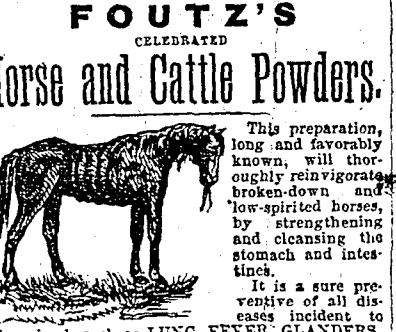
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
