for pensions to widows of deceased soldiers or sailors having children by such soldiers or sailors, at the rate of two dollars per month for each child of coldier or sailor under the age of six teen years. To derive benefit from this act i s necessary to make new application, surren

ering the old certificate. SEC. 3 gives an increase of pensions to those widdws now receiving a pension of less than eight dollars per month, except Revolutionary widows. Applications for Pensions must be made be

fore the Prothonotary.

BOUNTIES. THE BILL TO EQUALIZE BOUNTIES HAS BECOME A LAW: The following

is an analysis of its provisions : 1. \$100 to three years' men who served their

time. 2. \$100 to three years men discharged by reason of wounds received in service. 3. \$109 to the widow, minor children, or pa-

rents, in the order named, of any such soldier who died of wounds or disease contracted in service. 4. \$50 to each soldier not included in the foregoing classes who enlisted for two years or more, and discharged after serving two years.



in the line of duty. 6: \$50 to the widow, de. as above, of every soldier enlisted for less than two years, who died in service, or of wounds or disease contract-
