National Union Republican Convention.

The undersigned, constituting the National Committee designated by the Convention held at Chicago on the 10th of May, 1871, hereby call a convention of the Union Republican party at the city of Philadelphia, on Wednesday, the 15th day of February, 1872, for the purpose of nominating candidates for the offices of President and Vice-President of the United States.

Each State is authorized to be represented in the Convention by delegates equal to twice the number of Senators and Representatives to which it is entitled in the next Congress, and each Territory is authorized to send two delegates.

In calling this Convention, the Committee reminds the country that the members of the National Republican Convention of 1868 have fulfilled the States' duty in relation to the election of a President and Vice-President, and the national credit fairly established.

On the 29th of January, 1872, the House of Representatives passed a bill to amend an act to incorporate a society to prevent cruelty to animals.

The case of Henry Ward, recently tried for the killing of Wesley E. Shaker, was decided at Tunkhannock last Friday.

Last week was one of railroad disasters. The one at Lock Haven on Monday, was followed by one in Kentucky, where a train ran into a depot platform, and one at Laramie City, on the Pacific road, where four engines came crashing into the rear end of a waiting passenger train.

Henry W. Gray, the regular Republican candidate was elected Senator over A. K. McClure, last week Tuesday, by a majority of 387 votes.

The libel law of Pennsylvania is a disgrace to the State and the age. It is substantially the same law which one brilliant effort of Alexander Hamilton's genius overthrew forever in the State of New York more than two generations ago.
