CHEESE.—We have tried a few pounds of the Round Top Factory cheese, and can pronounce it first-rate. Though not more than a month old it is firm, fragrant of pure casein, and very palatable. By the statement published last week it will be seen that the factory is doing a larger business than last year. This will be found to be the tendency of all properly conducted factories. Without doubt the Delmar factory will double, perhaps treble its present work next year.
