ADDITIONAL BOUNTY.—At the suggestion of a friend, we make an abstract of a portion of Washington dispatch to the *Tribune*, relating to additional bounties. The Second Auditor has received 294,839 inquiries touching claims for additional bounty. These inquiries are being answered at the rate of from 400 to 500 per day, employing 43 clerks in that department.

The Second Auditor states that but 43 clerks can be employed without getting in each other's way. Of course, then, unless Congress make some measure of relief, it will require ten years to settle and pay the applications on file at present. It is known that these claims are accumulating day by day, claimants will understand that they must wait until their letters are reached in the "regulatory course" of business.
