UNCLE SAM GETS A FLOOD OF REPLIES

Official Texts Received on Naval War Zone and American Flag Incident

WILHELMINA CASE IS ALSO INCLUDED

State Department Willing to Let Letter Affair Be Adjudicated by a Prize Court—Great Britain Answers in Stars and Stripes Case

Washington, Feb. 20.—Official texts of Germany's reply to the American note on the naval war zone and Great Britain's replies to the American notes on the use of the American flag and the Wilhelmina case, all arrived to-day at the State Department.

The German reply, delivered by the Berlin Foreign Office three days ago to Ambassador Gerard, had been delayed in transmission. It was at once converted from the diplomatic code and sent to the White House to be laid before the President, who, however, had already been informed of its contents by Mr. Gerard and the unofficial text published two days ago.

German Note Friendly With the official text at hand, however, the President and his advisers will begin formal consideration of Germany's reply to the warning of the United States against destruction of American ships or lives in the naval war zone about the British Isles.

Responsibility on America? Berlin, Feb. 20, Via London, 12.55 P. M.—The Berlin newspapers with the exception of the "Kreuz Zeitung" publish without comment a Washington dispatch received by way of Amsterdam in which Secretary Daniels, of the United States Navy, is quoted as saying that no American warships would be used to convoy American merchantmen.
