

breakers often a colt the first tuckling up the can draw it to high, and then to run half a day one of the worst could inflict on a colt, very injurious to a young horse that has been running in pasture with his hind down. A horse should be well accustomed to the bit before the biting harness is put on; and when he is first bitted he should only be reined up to first he holds his head, let it be high or low; he will learn that he cannot lower his head, and that raising it a little will loosen the bit in his mouth. This will give him the idea of raising his head to loosen his bit, and then you can draw the bit a little tighter every time you put it on, and he will raise his head to loosen it. By this means you can gradually get his head and neck in the position you wish him to carry it, and give him a graceful carriage without hurting him, making him angry, or causing his mouth to be sore.

SHOEING HORSES.
Were you to examine the first one hundred horses you meet that have been shod for several years, you would scarcely find one that has a natural, well shaped hoof.
A friend brought me for examination, a beautiful, spirited animal, that, without perceptible cause, became so lame as to be nearly useless. The owner feared a founder. On examination I found the farrier had, by repeated close paring and rasping, nearly ruined the best. The enamel of the hoof had been broken, and fine dirt was irritating the "quick." The bottom of the hoof had been shaved so thin that a light blow between the frog and toe made the animal cringe with pain. Another instance of mal-practice that came under my notice was of a horse that had a club foot, caused by improper side clipping. This horse had by nature an uncommonly broad hoof, and to remedy the defect the farrier had made extensive incisions on the sides, and nature, to restore the equilibrium, and reconstruct the missing part, contracted the toe and bulged the sides above where they had been clipped, producing thus a great deformity. Almost universally, where lameness occurs from flat foot, it is occasioned by improper shoeing. Where this defect exists, the heel should never be pared, and the shoe should be made stiff enough to prevent hard pressure on the heel, and it is sometimes advisable to place the heel cork on one side of the shoe. Very bad cases have been remedied by putting on a round shoe, with leather or rubber between the shoe and hoof. If too many nails are inserted, the natural expansion of the hoof is prevented, and disease or deformity must ensue; more than five nails in a shoe can never be needed, unless it be to hide clumsy fitting. The weight of the horse is best equalized by placing three nails in the outer portion of the shoe, and two in the inner portion, between the toe and commencement of the inner quarter.

The following rules are given by a distinguished veterinary surgeon:
1st. After having taken off the old shoe, shorten the toe, and remove all the dead and loose parts of the hoof. Do not cut the sole or pare the frog unless the foot has received an injury from a nail or otherwise, when it must be cut out.
2d. Let the shoe be of equal thickness, with the exception of the heel, which should be rather thinner. The ground and foot surface should be perfectly level. Too many nails are objectionable, and those used should be kept as far as possible from the heels.
3d. For the hind feet there is no objection to calkins, though they are of doubtful benefit. Horses travel much better without them. The hind shoes are made thicker at the toes than at the quarters, and the nails can be put closer to the heels without inconvenience.
4th. Side clips should be avoided, they destroy the hoof, this is the case when the nails are too close together. The feet should never be rasped, as it destroys the enamel of the hoof, renders them brittle, and causes sandcracks and lameness.—*Rural American.*

CAKED UDDERS.
It is stated in an exchange that a cow with a caked bag may be cured by tying her in a stable in which horses are kept. A few nights will complete the cure.—It is probable that the strong ammonia vapors which arise in warm weather from the horse stable is the remedial agent. If so, would not spirits of hartshorn, applied in small quantities, directly to the caked bag, be effectual? Care should be used in making the application, as too much might raise a blister.

TO FRESHEN SALT BUTTER.
Churn the butter with new milk, in the proportion of a pound of butter to a quart of milk. Treat the butter in all respects in churning as if it was fresh.
Bad butter may be improved greatly by dissolving it thoroughly in hot water. Let it cool, then skim it off and churn again in milk, adding a small quantity salt and sugar. A small quantity may be tried and approved before trying a larger one. The water should be merely hot enough to melt the butter.
