



trifle thicker than the wheels, as broad as the side strips are and about one inch long. Make two holes in each strip two and a half inches from the ends and the size of the axles.

Now you are ready to join the parts. Take two side strips, one large and one small spool, place the axles in the holes, put a block in position at each end and fasten it firmly by means of glue or screws or nails. A screw book

in each end completes one part. Make the other part in exactly the same way and put in the cord as

shown in the drawing. To use the pulley, fasten one block to the ceiling or some other high place. Attach the lower block to the object you wish to raise. It will seem surprisingly how heavy a weight can be
