Those Which Have Been Through Quarantine Will Hereafter Be Incinerated, by Order of the Board of Health

Books belonging to the public chools of Sayre borough which have passed through quarantine will hereafter be burned. Heretofore when books have been taken from the school building to homes which have afterward been invaded by contagious disease, it has been customary for the health officer to fumigate the books and then they would be returned to the school building. The practice is to be discontinued and the books will be incinerated by order of the board of health. This practice is believed to have been a most successful means of spreading infection.
