Presidential Combinations.

Four years ago the electoral vote was 401. This year it is increased to 444; necessary to a choice, 223. The reapportionment based upon the census and the admission of six new States, Idaho, Wyoming, Washington, Montana and North and South Dakota, are responsible for the increase.

In this calculation the Republicans are nine votes short of a majority. The doubtful States cost this vote: Connecticut, New Jersey, Indiana, New York, West Virginia, New Hampshire, Rhode Island, South Dakota, Vermont, Washington, Wisconsin, Wyoming.

divide in this manner this year the vote would stand: Republican.....285 | Democratic.....159 The Democrats are talking about carrying Kansas, Colorado and Nevada-total 17. To these they might add Wisconsin, Montana, Idaho, North Dakota and South Dakota, seven Republican States in all, with a total of 42 votes, and still Harrison would be elected by the exact majority required, the vote standing: Republican 223; Democratic, 201.
