Pittsburg, Oct. 24.
In the closing days of what has been a more or less exciting political campaign the Democratic managers are making a desperate effort to turn the tide in favor of William H. Berry, the Prohibition-Democratic-Lincolnton candidate for state treasurer.

Everything has been going against Berry since the day he was nominated, and his defeat by an overwhelming majority is inevitable. They know this, but they still hope to cut down the Republican vote by continuing their schemes of misrepresentation and deliberate falsehood.

The failure of the Enterprise Bank was at once seized upon as furnishing a new field for activity in their peculiar and unenviable methods of campaigning. They have been striving to have it appear that some of the Republican state leaders are, in some inexplicable way, responsible for the closing of the bank, but they have not been able to produce a scintilla of evidence to substantiate their vague intimations.

A Young Man's Statements.
Homer Castle, one of the Prohibition nominees for the Superior court, who has been going up and down the state making wild and irresponsible allegations regarding the management of the state finances, has been one of the most conspicuous of those who have been trying to use the failure of the Enterprise Bank to advance political interests.

Up to the time of his nomination, Castle was not known outside of the small circle of acquaintances near his home, and among them he had little standing as a lawyer, as it has not been long since he was an office boy in a law firm here. Nevertheless he has assumed to speak of matters of which he could not possibly have personal knowledge, as though he were fully and authoritatively informed as to facts and circumstances.

The despicable attempt to connect Senator Penrose with the affairs of this bank was met with a prompt and emphatic denial from the senior senator, as well as with a public statement from John R. Cunningham, the United States bank examiner.

Penrose's Prompt Denial.
This is Senator Penrose's signed statement which effectually nailed the lie, circulated for political purposes, that he had a note in the Enterprise Bank:

"I have no obligations of any kind in the Enterprise National Bank. I am not connected in any way, directly or indirectly, with the notes of W. H. Andrews, if there are any such in the Enterprise National Bank. I have no interest whatever in the Pennsylvania Development Company or with any other project in New Mexico. Any intimations to the contrary are malicious falsehoods for political effect."
(Signed) "BOIES PENROSE."

Following this statement from Senator Penrose, Bank Examiner Cunningham made public this announcement:
"An examination of the papers in the bank shows that there is no paper there with the name of Senator Penrose upon it, either as maker, indorser or guarantor."
Despite these positive statements showing that Senator Penrose's name was used in this connection without authority or justification of any kind, the Democrats have continued to distort the facts in trying to win votes for their candidate for state treasurer.

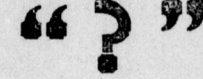
But there is no reason to believe that they will be successful in that direction.

There is no Berry sentiment in this part of the state, and from what is heard from other sections the same condition of affairs exists everywhere throughout the commonwealth.

The Berry candidacy has been more or less of a joke. It has not been taken seriously even by many Democrats who, when they heard that their party had put up a Prohibitionist to head their state ticket, at once reached the conclusion that the Democratic ticket was doomed to defeat by even more than the usual majority.

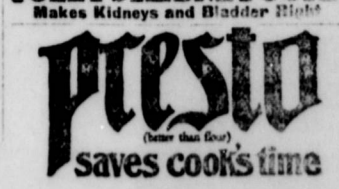

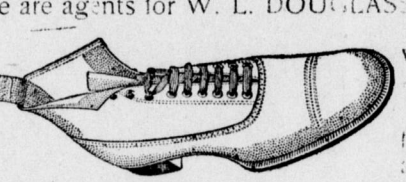

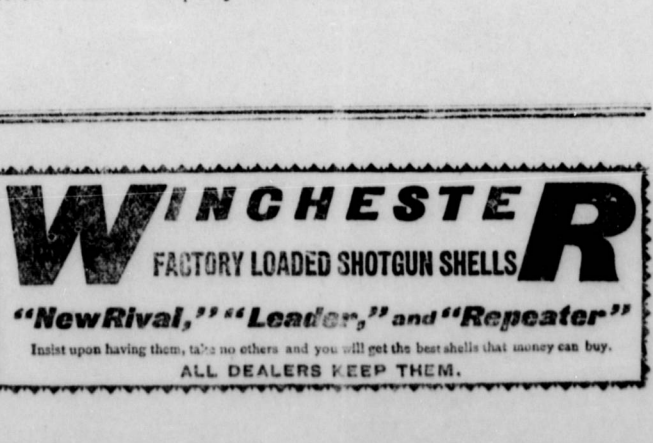
