Executors' Sale.

By virtue of authority and direction contained in the last Will and Testament of John O. Wilson, late of Davidson Township, Sullivan County, Pennsylvania, deceased, the undersigned executor of said decedent will expose to public sale at the hotel of Harry Basley, in the village of Sonestown, Sullivan County, Pa. **THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 15th, 1906**, commencing at 1 o'clock p.m. the following described real estate late of John O. Wilson, deceased, to wit:

Lot No. 1: All that certain lot, piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the Township of Davidson, in the County of Sullivan, and State of Penn'a, bounded and described as follows, viz:

BEGINNING at a hemlock thence South 58 1/2 degrees East 216.5 rods to a post and stone; thence South 49 degrees West 106 rods to a small sugar; thence North 60 degrees West 12 rods to a post; thence South 57 1/2 degrees West 16 rods to a post; thence North 25 1/2 degrees West 36 rods to a post; thence North 69 degrees East 14.7 rods to a hemlock; thence North 18 1/2 degrees West 38 rods to a sugar; thence North 28 1/2 degrees West 118 rods to a beech; thence North 32 degrees East 16.7 rods to a hemlock corner, the place of beginning. **CONTAINING** Eighty-eight acres, be the same more or less.

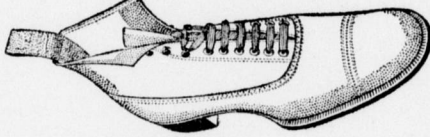

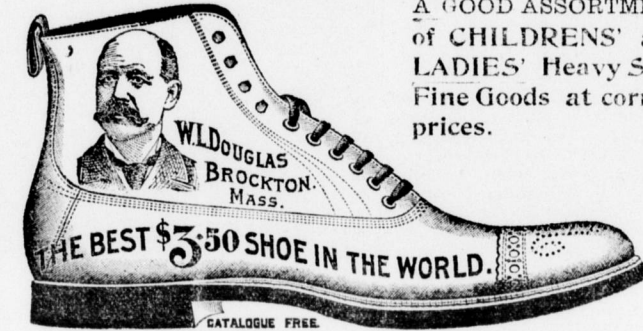
