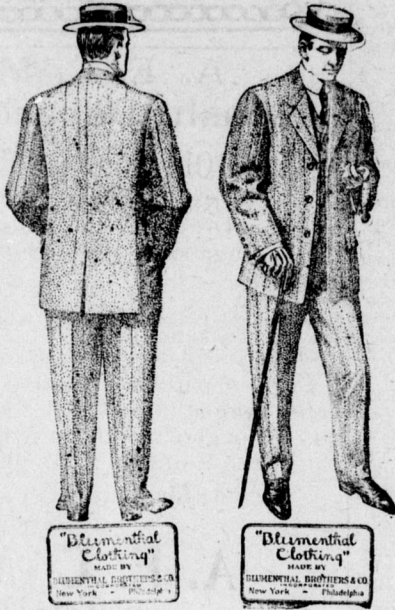

We want an exhibit from every member of your family; the father can exhibit in the live stock department, the mother and the grown up sister in the household departments, while the children can help us in their own field.

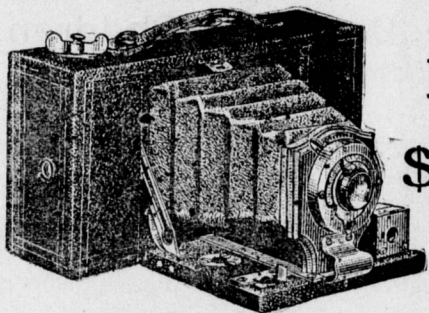
