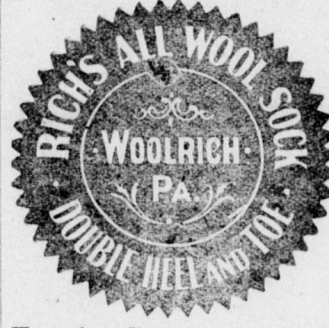
The Agricultural Society has offered a cup to be contested for by the Athletic Societies of the High Schools of Sullivan County on the second day of the Fair.

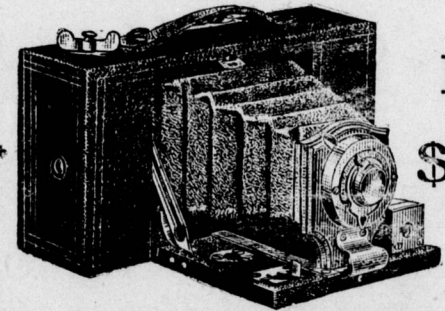
