Terry, President Judge of the Court of Common Pleas of Sullivan Co., on Monday, May 18, 1908, at 2 o'clock p. m., for the charter of a corporation to be called "The Mildred Benevolent Association of Mildred, Sullivan County, Pennsylvania" the character and object of which are to unite fraternally white male persons into a fraternal, beneficial society or association, with a ritualistic form of work, for beneficial and protective purposes, by providing for the payment of benefits to its members or to their beneficiaries in case of death, sickness, temporary or permanent disability, whether death, sickness or disability result from disease, accident or old age; to provide a fund from which said benefits may be paid, and the expenses of said corporation may be defrayed, by charging initiation fees to all persons who may become members of said society, and by dues and assessments levied upon and collected from each of said members; to provide a constitution and by-laws not inconsistent with the laws of this Commonwealth or those of the United States. 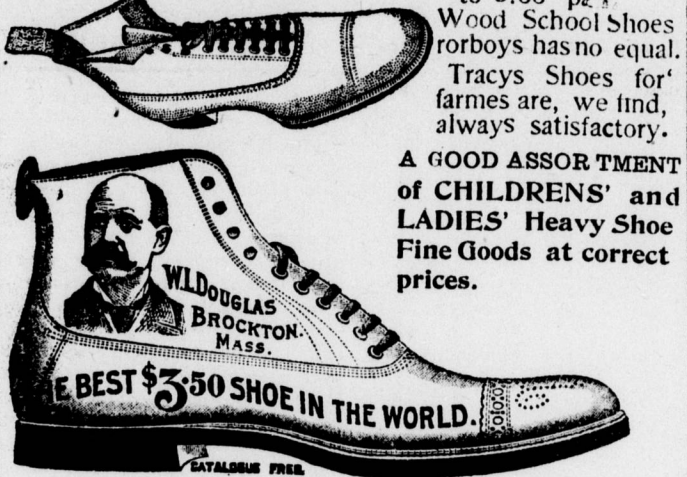
