Friday morning, March 29, Samuel Ward of Earlton, near Everett, took some posts to the sawmill, about a half mile from his home.

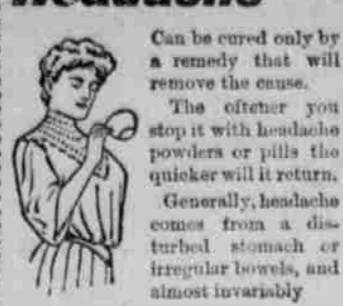
