Woods Given Sixticen Years' Additiona Service by Preservative Treatment.
Fence posts of many kinds Fence posts of many kinds of
cheap woods which ordinarily would soon decay if set in the ground, can be made to last for twenty years by a simple treat
ment with creosote. Most of the so-called "inferior" wonds are
well adapted well adapted to the treatment,
and this is especially and thas is especially true of cot
tonwood, aspen, willow, syca more, low grade piwes, and some of the gums. When properl treated cedar and oak, which are becoming too scarce and too much
