School Reports.

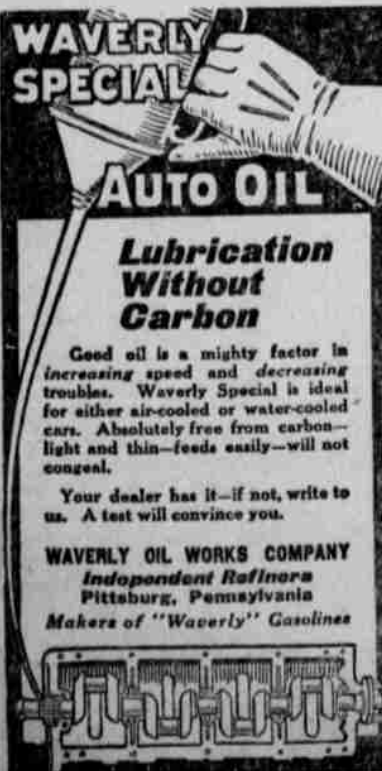

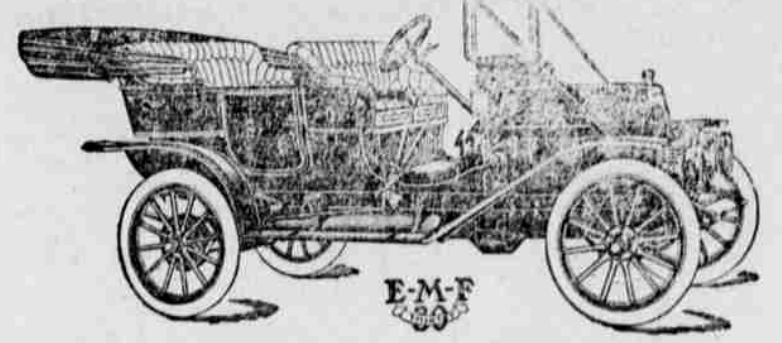

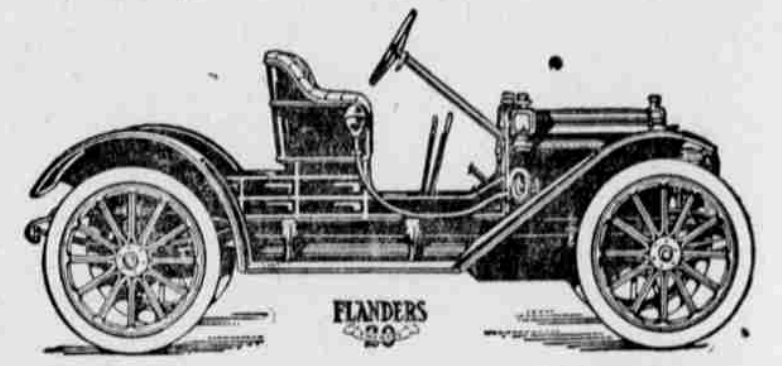
