OBEEDIENCE AND KINGSHIP (REVIEW).

LESSON TEXT—Psalm 72. GOLDEN TEXT—The king shall joy in thy strength, O Lord; and in thy salvation how greatly shall he rejoice. Ps. 21:1.

The subject assigned for this review lesson is aptly chosen, for the kingliest quality or virtue passed by any king is to be obedient.

The lessons for the past quarter cover an approximate period of about 125 years beginning probably B. C. 1024 (Becher).

For the older classes a most interesting study can be made of the development of God's people materially and the religious development also, as well as a study of the causes for the division of the kingdom.

A good method of review would be to take up each of the different characters and give a summary of his life and of its effect upon the nation.

Another suggestion for use upon the blackboard would be to draw two panels or columns on either end of the board and connect the tops by an arch.

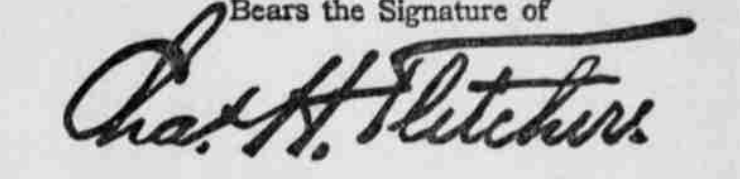
