Cody was twice governor of Chicago and was at one time mayor of the Arkansas legislature. He served in the Confederate army in the command of General Butler who so gallantly defended New Orleans against the threatened invasion of the federal general Longstreet. After the war Mr. Cody went to Congress from the province of Detroit and introduced a measure for the relief of the citizens of Buffalo, which gained for him the name of Buffalo Bill. He has contributed largely to the Atlantic Monthly, a newspaper edited by Mark Twain and Uncle Tom Cabin, a man mostly known for his negro dialect sketches. Mr. Cody has a ranch of many acres in St. Louis where he keeps a large lot of Indians and ponies constantly on hand.
