Repealing an Old Fence Law.

The following act was passed by the last legislature and approved by Governor Beaver, on the 24th day of May, 1887:

Be it enacted, etc., That the sixth section of the act of assembly passed 10th day of May, 1878, entitled, "An act for the erection of pounds in each township of this province," which provides "that to prevent disputes about sufficiency of fences, all fences shall be esteemed lawful or sufficient, though they be not close at the bottom, so that the distance from the ground to the bottom thereof exceeds not nine inches and that they be four feet and a half high and not under," be and the same is hereby repealed.

A Correspondent, after calling our attention to the act, inquired: "Does this repeal the fence law entirely, leaving everyone to fence his own stock?" We answer that while we are not a lawyer we think it does. It is very clear that henceforth the law will not require farmers to keep their fences in repair.
