Chairman Cooper Issues The Call For The Republican State Convention.

HEADQUARTERS REPUBLICAN STATE COMMITTEE Philadelphia, Jan. 21, 1888.

The Republican State Convention will be held in the Opera House at Harrisburg, on the last Wednesday of April, the 25th, 1888.

First.—That Delegates to the State Convention shall be chosen in the manner in which candidates for the General Assembly are nominated.

Second.—Hereafter the State Convention of the Republican Party shall be held not earlier than the third Wednesday of August.

Third.—That we recommend to the county organizations, that in their Rules they allow the largest freedom in the general participation in the primaries consistent with the preservation of the party organization.
