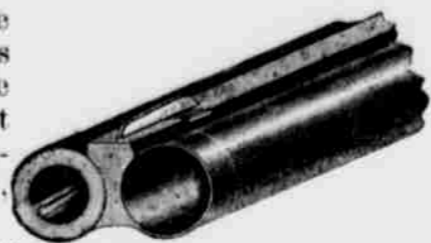


Mrs. Dart's Triplets.

The Piper Breech-Loading Shot-Gun and Rifle Combined.

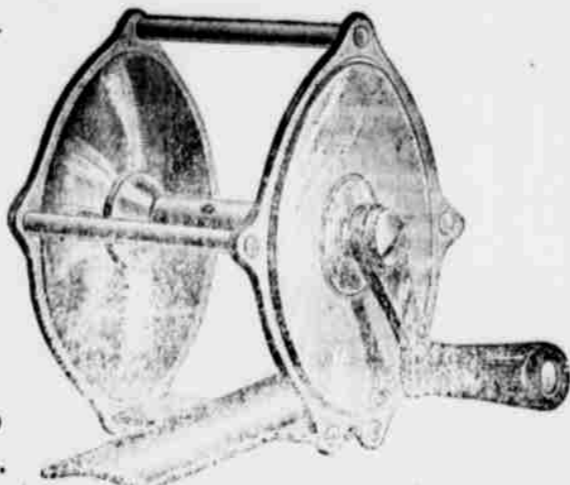
