Farming.

In my former articles I tried to show the farmer some points to his advantage in farming, will now still further show him how he may restore to the ground those elements which we yearly take away from it. The three principle elements that enter into the fertility of the ground, are nitrogen, phosphoric acid, and potash; now if any one of these three are wanting the consequences are a deficient crop, wheat takes from the soil about fifty-two pounds of nitrogen per ton, twenty-one of phosphoric acid, and thirteen of potash, potatoes about fourteen and a half of potash, eight of nitrogen and four of phosphoric acid. Now it remains for the farmer to step out of the old ruts and make use of the information which we can obtain gratis from the experiment stations of each and every state. The farmer of the last thirty years may call this book farming or what he pleases, or may poke fun at those who practice this mode of farming—in an intelligent way. What farmer would employ a Dr. who was a quack, and lacked a regular course of medicine. Most certainly he would employ the very best, the same holds true to the student of Blackstone, or any of our professional men. The farmer is bound by the inevitable to adopt new ideas and a more scientific way of doing his work, if he desires to make farming pay. After the soil is exhausted it will bring forth only imperfectly. This holds true not only to cereals but also to all kinds of fruit and grasses. Let the close observer travel through any farming district, and he will notice where wheat stubble may be turned down for the third or fourth time in succession, because the grass did not catch. Now let the good farmer stop and think for a moment why it did not catch, and then apply the remedy, instead of keeping on in the old way, making his land poorer still, every successive crop of wheat or of any crop (without restoring some of the waste) will surely make his land less fertile every season. The writer does not advocate the use of fertilizers indiscriminately, but every farmer should experiment on a small scale, and find out what special manure his land lacks and govern himself thereby. If there is an excess of straw the wheat will lodge, the same holds true of the potato, if there is a lack of potash you will have all stalk and no potatoes, or very small ones. When all the grain such as oats, corn and wheat is sold, and only a small portion fed, the manure may be large in bulk, but poor in grain-farming. This manure is then spread over twice the acres it should lie, and the season is blamed, where often it is the farmer himself who should be blamed. Farm less acres, more per acre and see if farming don't pay. Use more brains instead of muscle. Read the papers, and find out what farmers are doing in other sections. Don't stand idle with your arms folded, and be called only an ignorant farmer, but show the world that it takes an intelligent man to make a good and successful farmer.

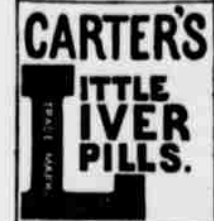
